- We have provided over \$1.1 billion for the financing of 22,000 rental units

ONE Mortgage

- First time homebuyer program
- Over 19,300 low- and moderate-income families have purchased their first homes with over \$3.1 billion in private financing

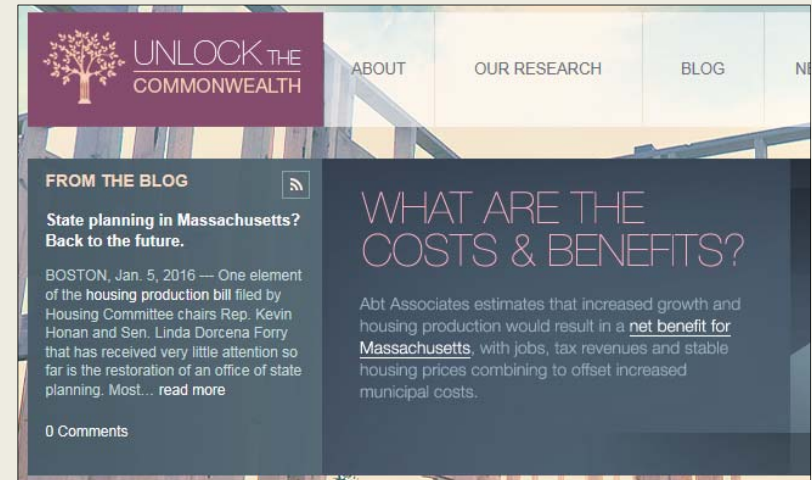
The Importance of Housing

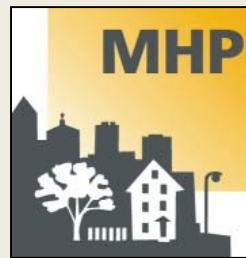
